Climatic conditions in Europe and closure of London Heathrow cause major disruptions to flight schedules

No operations to London Heathrow today 19 December 2010

The climatic conditions in Europe and the closure of London Heathrow airport are causing major disruptions to all airline operations.

Flight MK 046 of 18 Dec has been diverted to Milan Malpensa airport and all passengers have been provided with accommodation.

Flight MK 057 of 18 Dec has subsequently been delayed until further notice.

Flight MK 6042 of 19 Dec will be diverted to Milan due to continued closure of London Heathrow. Passengers will be provided with accommodation.

Flight MK 053 of 19 Dec is subsequently be delayed until further notice.

Operations to Europe will be disrupted over the next days and passengers are invited to consult our website www.airmauritius.com or our call centre (Mauritius Call Centre +2306033030) for updates on our schedules.

Air Mauritius is doing its best to minimise inconvenience to passengers. The teams in Mauritius and at the various stations in Europe are mobilised round the clock and awaiting clearance from the airport authorities to resume operations in London and minimise delays on the rest of the network.

A further release will be issued once London Heathrow is cleared for operations.
