Snow in Europe continues to cause major disruptions to airlines. Air Mauritius flights affected.

The snow in Europe continues to affect airline operations worldwide and Air Mauritius flights are also affected.

- Flight MK045 of 23rd December from Paris, scheduled to arrive in Mauritius this morning was considerably delayed as a result of deicing procedures and had to be diverted to Nairobi because of mandatory crew rest limitations. The flight will now leave Nairobi this evening at 21h50 and reach Mauritius on 25th December at 02h45. The 186 passengers on board have been accommodated in hotels in Nairobi.
- MK 051 (operated by Air France) from Paris arrived in Mauritius at 10h20
- MK047 from Paris will arrive in Mauritius at 15h25

As a consequence of the above disruptions, the following flights are delayed:

- MK040 (operated by Air France) departure to Paris is now scheduled at 12h35
- MK036 departure to Paris is now scheduled at 13h30

Air Mauritius apologises for all the inconveniences caused to its passengers and wishes to assure them that it is doing its best to resume its normal schedules as soon as possible.
