Snow still continues to affect travel plans of thousands of passengers. Air Mauritius flights delayed

The climatic conditions in Europe continue to cause havoc to travel in Europe with snowball effects worldwide.

Air Mauritius flight MK 048 could not land in Frankfurt last night and was diverted to Geneva. Passengers to and from Frankfurt are being sent by coach to/from Frankfurt. Flight MK 059 now expected to land in Mauritius at 23h00 today 25 December.

Air Mauritius flights from Paris are also affected. Passengers of flight MK 045 of 24 December from Paris and MK 036 of 25 December have been transferred on alternative flights to their final destination.
