MK681 of 22 November from Shanghai and Kuala Lumpur is delayed

Air Mauritius regrets to announce that its flight MK 681 scheduled for the 22nd of November from Shanghai and Kuala Lumpur is delayed following a technical problem.

The required spare part was not available and had to be sourced. It only arrived in Shanghai this evening and it is now expected that repairs can be completed tomorrow morning following which a new schedule will be announced.

Passengers have been accommodated in Shanghai and in Kuala Lumpur and the Air Mauritius teams in Shanghai and in Kuala Lumpur are keeping in constant touch with them.

Air Mauritius apologises for the inconvenience caused by this delay and reiterates that the safety of passengers and crew remain its topmost priority.
